ODHE Priorities for Completion Plans

- Indication of how students will be advised on pathways to graduation and careers
- Attention to outcomes for adult students over age 25
- Alignment to the state's workforce development priorities



Guided Pathways Essential Practices: Top Five Priorities for TA

1. **Simplify students' choices with default program maps that show a clear pathway to completion, further education, and employment.**
2. **Support students through a strong advising process, embedded and ongoing in the pathway experience.**
3. Embed academic and non-academic supports throughout students' programs.
4. Redesign traditional remediation as an "on-ramp" to a program of study.
5. Provide accelerated remediation to help very poorly prepared students.



Guided Pathways Essential Capacities: Top Three Priorities for TA

1. Technological tools and infrastructure to support student progress through guided pathways.
2. Institutional will and capacity to use data and evidence.
3. Broad and authentic engagement of college faculty and staff—particularly advisors.
