 - Connect SSLI teams with national and state experts available to provide TA and coaching on campus. Handle logistics for campus visits including travel arrangements, contracts, etc.


Next Steps: Data Team

- Cross-functional team of 4 – 6. Include institutional research (IR) officer, Information Technology (IT), someone familiar with academic issues, and someone with insight into student services.
- Primary roles:
 - Examining data to understand patterns of student success
 - Identifying priority areas to look into more deeply
 - Communicating key findings to the SSLI team
 - Monitoring progress on student success metrics
 - Supporting evaluation of strategies in the campus completion plan
- **First meeting: Friday, April 29 at North Central**
- Data coaching to begin in May

Next Steps: SSLI Team

- Assessment of guided pathways work and technical assistance needs (*Pathways Readiness Assessment*)
- JFF Institutional Policy Audit:
 - OACC will provide support to aggregate survey responses for review on campus
