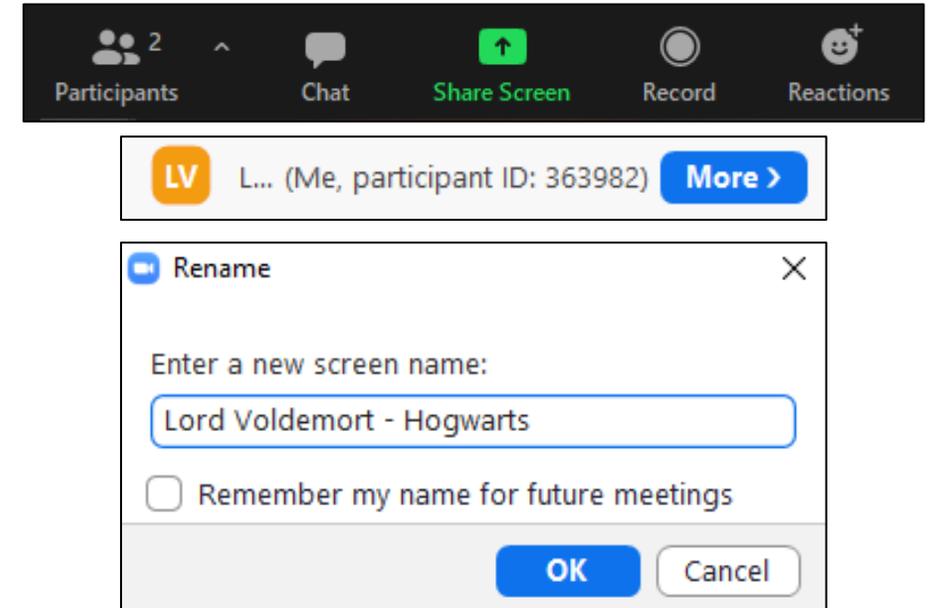

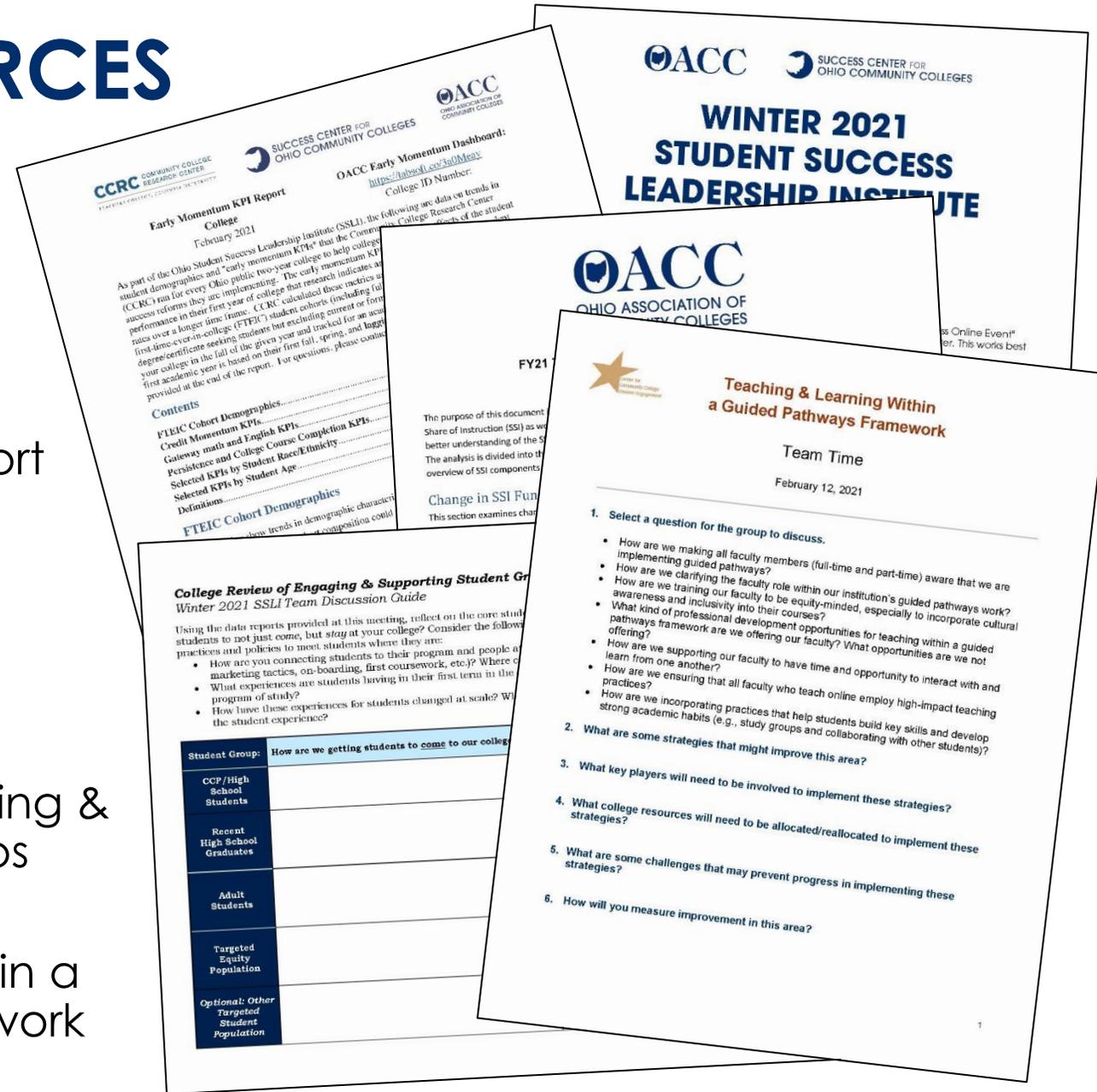

## Campus Completion Plans



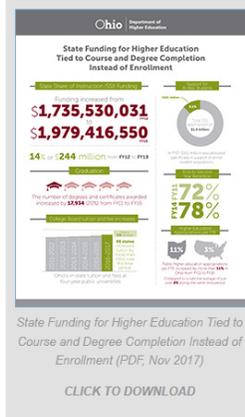
House Bill 59 called for each public college and university to submit a campus completion plan that was approved by their board of trustees to the Chancellor by June 30, 2014. The legislation further states that these plans are to be updated every two years. Completion plans provide a continuous improvement framework that can allow campuses to identify and implement strategies to increase the number and percentage of students earning meaningful postsecondary credentials. # ODHE NAMES DR. TOM SUDKAMP AS NEW VICE CHANCELLOR OF ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

### Ohio Department of Higher Education Names Sudkamp as Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs

The Ohio Department of Higher Education (ODHE) has named Dr. Thomas Sudkamp as its new Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs, effective January 11, 2021. Dr. Sudkamp fills the role vacated by Dr. Stephanie Davidson, who retired at the end of 2020 after more than 33 years of service in education, including 13 years with ODHE.

Dr. Sudkamp has served ODHE since 2019 as the executive director of the Ohio Strong Start to Finish program, a collaboration of 30 public community colleges and universities designed to increase the number of students who complete gateway mathematics and English courses in their first year of study. Prior to that, he served in various academic leadership roles over more than three decades in higher education, most recently as provost and vice president for curriculum and instruction at Wright State University.

"I am pleased with the wealth of experience and the breadth of knowledge that Dr. Sudkamp brings to this position," said Chancellor Randy Gardner. "His familiarity with the Strong Start to Finish program and established relationships with Ohio's colleges and universities will enable him to have a positive impact on day one. I am confident that the critical issues of postsecondary access, student success, and higher education-practice alignment will continue to be prioritized under Tom's leadership."

Dr. Sudkamp earned his bachelor's degree in mathematics from the University of Wisconsin-Madison; master's degrees in mathematics and computer science from the University of Notre Dame and Wright State University, respectively; and his Ph.D. in mathematics from Notre Dame.

As Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs, Sudkamp will serve the department – and the state – as its Chief Academic Officer, a senior-level academic leader who provides key input on policies, practices, and the overall quality of postsecondary education offered throughout Ohio. He will have administrative responsibility for numerous areas within the department, including articulation and transfer, program development and review, and student access and success. He will ensure the quality and integrity of Ohio's postsecondary academic programming while working with other state and national leaders on key higher education issues and providing counsel to the Chancellor to place the department at the forefront of higher education.

The Ohio Department of Higher Education is a Cabinet-level agency for the Governor of Ohio that oversees higher education for the state. The agency's main responsibilities include authorizing and approving [new degree programs](#), managing state-funded [financial aid](#) programs and developing and advocating [policies](#) to maximize higher education's contributions to the state and its citizens.
