2021 and increased by 2.9% (\$216,140) since FY 2019 as some Success Points changed in FY 2022 SSI (see Tables 2 through 14 for more details)
Netted FTE overall and for all categories of Access between 2020 and 2021; Non-Access Completed FTE in 2020 and 2021; all subcomponents improved with the same Success Points over the past three years. Success Points were redefined for FY2018, and increased from 2017 to 2020 and from 2019 to 2020; Netted FTE improved as well.
